Regarding Inspection & Cleaning of Hood Systems

Dear WMFRD Customer,

Each year, on average, in the United States there are over 8,000 fires at restaurants that cause over \$245 million in property damage. Keeping your hood system properly maintained will go a long way in reducing these devastating numbers. Florida Fire Prevention Code (FFPC) (7th ed.) 50.5.4 states, "The entire exhaust system shall be inspected for grease buildup by a <u>properly trained</u>, qualified, and certified person(s) acceptable to the authority having jurisdiction (AHJ)."

Furthermore, FFPC 50.5.6.1 states, "If upon inspection, the exhaust system is found to be contaminated with deposits from grease-laden vapors, the contaminated portions of the exhaust system shall be cleaned by a properly trained, qualified **and certified** person(s) acceptable to the AHJ."

West Manatee Fire Rescue District, your local AHJ, currently recognizes hood inspections and cleaning services performed by companies with certification by one of the following national credentialling agency's: International Kitchen Exhaust Cleaning Association (IKECA), Certified National Hood Cleaning Association (CNHCA), MFStradeSchool, Phil Ackland Kitchen Hood Cleaning School & Certified Hood & Duct Cleaners Association (CHDCA).
