Subject: Resolution #2023-06 Budget Amendment 2022-2023 Fiscal Year

Overview

Amendments have been made to the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget to reflect the rising costs of fuel and supplies. The funds have been reduced in our Reserve Pay and Retirement Health Savings to reflect fiscal year end projections and have been added to Office Supplies and Fuel. The Miscellaneous Line Item has also been increased in preparation for Year End essential purchases.

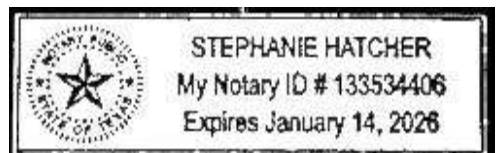
